

## POST WITH FIVE RINGS

Only four inches high, this little stacker uses brightly colored bracelets or macrame rings for its stacking. The child uses a pincer grasp to remove the rings from the peg. Putting the rings back on is easy because the ring is so much larger than the peg.





SOLD AS BRACELETS, THE RINGS MAY HAVE A PATTERN AS SHOWN. WHILE SOLD AS MACRAME RINGS THEY ARE SMOOTH. RINGS ARE 1/4" x 3/8" DIA. AND IN MANY COLORS. AVAILABLE FROM A CRAFTS SUPPLY STORE.

TEST THESE RINGS BEFORE PURCHASE BY DROPPING ONE ON THE FLOOR A FEW TIMES.

AVOID THOSE TYPES OF RINGS THAT BREAK, AS THEY LEAVE VERY SHARP POINTS

## POST WITH FIVE RINGS

## Materials needed:

- 3½" x 3½" x 3/8" birch plywood
- 7/8" x 4-3/8" dowel
- Elmer's Carpenter Glue
- 5 bracelets or macrame rings in various colors: 1/4" x 3-1/8" in diameter
- Varathane or equivalent enamel in bright colors

## Tools needed:

- Saw
- Electric drill and 7/8" drill (a drill press is a very handy tool for this)
- Sandpaper or sander
